

Program authorization for: Officer candidate indoctrination and training of college graduates for appointment and active duty as Ensigns in the restricted line, U.S. Naval Reserve, Aerospace Engineering Duty (Aviation Maintenance) Officer (1525). N131/NPC-211D is the community manager.

I. Program authority: 10 USC 12201

II. Quota:

As established by the Deputy Chief of Naval Operations (Manpower and Personnel).

III. Qualifications:

A. **Citizenship:** Applicants must be citizens of the United States.

B. **Sex:** Open to men and women.

C. **Age:** Must be at least 19 but less than 35 years of age at time of commissioning.

D. **Education:** Graduate of an accredited college or university with a Baccalaureate Degree. Preferred fields of study are business, engineering, and physical science.

E. **Mental qualifications:** Aviation Selection Test Battery (ASTB) - 3 and Officer Aptitude Rating (OAR) - 40.

F. **Physical:** In accordance with the Manual of the Medical Department, Chapter 15.

G. **Marital status:** No restrictions.

IV. Source:

A. Civilian men and women.

B. Enlisted personnel of the Navy or the Naval Reserve (active or inactive).

C. Enlisted personnel (active or inactive) of other armed services with an approved conditional release from their service.

V. Indoctrination:

Thirteen weeks of training at Officer Candidate School (OCS) followed by ten weeks at Aviation Maintenance Officer School, both in Pensacola, Florida.

VI. Appointment:

Candidates will be commissioned in the restricted line of the Navy as Ensign, U. S. Naval Reserve, designator 1525.

VII. Active duty obligation:

Four years from date of appointment.
